Rules for SCDOS Member Displays

1. To reserve a space, the Exhibitor will get a location number from either Show Co-Chair Debby Halliday at debhallid@gmail.com or Jack Schaefer at Secretary@sdorchids.com IN ADVANCE of bringing in the plants for registration.
2. Reservations are on a first-come first-served basis. There may not be places for last-minute entries.
3. The Exhibitor must fill out this form and check either Amateur or Open Category.
4. Each display needs to be entered as a Small or Large Display and receive a location number showing table number such as "Table 30".
3. ONLY orchids, with the exception of greenery used as background or fill-in, will be used in displays/exhibits. Non-orchid flowers are prohibited.
3. Minimum of 3 flowering orchid plants must be in the display. No maximum number of orchids.
4. **A maximum of 7 (seven) flowering orchids used in an Exhibit may be entered in competitive Sections, provided the plants have two registration tags (one tag on the table in the proper Section with "SEE EXHIBIT NUMBER #, the other on the plant in the display), are labeled, and are easily accessible for judging.** Plants not easily reached might not be judged. The Judging Chair reserves the right to remove any plant entered for judging for closer inspection and accepts no responsibility for any damage to the Exhibit resulting from this removal.
5. No flammable materials can be used.
6. Electrical outlets provided as available at the discretion of the show chair. Displays using electrical outlets must have a master shut-off switch located at the front of the display in a non-obtrusive place so that electrical devices may be turned off for non-show hours.
- 7.. People who are selling orchids in the show should register in the Open division.
- 8.. All displays in the AMATEUR categories are eligible for the Orchid Digest Trophy.
