Ron Kaufmann: Conserving Orchids in the Wild

Ron Kaufmann and Ashley Grable, First VP

Text by Ron Kaufmann and Ashley Grable Ron Kaufmann has been growing orchids for more than 25 years and has traveled extensively to view orchids in the wild in Asia and South America, particularly in Brazil, Ecuador and Colombia. He has a long-standing interest in conservation and has been a member of the San Diego County Orchid Society (SDCOS) Conservation Committee for nearly 25 years. He has been its chair since 2004.

In 2005, Ron helped found the Orchid Conservation Alliance (OCA) with fellow

SDCOS member Peter Tobias and with Steve Beckendorf. The OCA supports the conservation of orchids through the protection of orchid habitat. During the past 20 years, the OCA has worked with local partners to protect nearly 4,600 acres of orchid-rich habitat, along with the rich diversity of animals and plants that thrive in these kinds of ecosystems. Ron's talk "Conserving Orchids in the Wild" will highlight some of the key projects that have been supported by the OCA, such as the *Dracula Reserve in Ecuador*. Ron currently serves as a Director of the OCA, as well as its Secretary.

In addition to his roles with SDCOS and OCA, Ron serves as a Trustee of the American Orchid Society (AOS) and the chair of its Conservation Committee. He also sits on the boards of Orchid Digest and Fundación EcoMinga, an Ecuadorian conservation organization.

Ron's orchid collection began with a reedstem *Epidendrum* and progressed to a diverse assemblage that contains mostly species orchids. Most of Ron's orchids are grown in a 36' x 24' greenhouse and several outdoor shade-covered areas around his house in San Diego. Friends have suggested that he build a second, much larger greenhouse to accommodate the many plants that often make walking through his greenhouse an exercise requiring extensive training in gymnastics and yoga to avoid serious injury. Thus far, this recommendation has not been followed, although the temptation is always there.



A marine biologist by training, Ron's scientific work includes studies of Antarctic and deep-sea ecosystems as well as marine communities in coastal Southern California. He also has a strong interest in aroids and is currently on the board of the International Aroid Society.



Spring Show Committee Report Debby Halliday, Show Chair

Your show committee has been hard at work and the plans for the Spring Show are coming together nicely. As a reminder, here are the details.

Orchids of the Earth Show & Sale
April 19-21 – Earth Day weekend
Casa del Prado, Room 101 and Patio A
Friday 12pm – 7pm (early bird sales at 10am)
Saturday 9am – 6pm
Sunday 10am – 4pm

There are a few changes from last spring. As we transition away from many years at Scottish Rite, we are still trying to work out the best configuration for the show. Last year was very nice, but also quite complicated and expensive. With record sales, we just barely broke even. This year we have opted to scale things down a bit but still host extra vendors and put on a bigger event than our other park shows. Our projections are that the show will make money for the club while requiring less effort to put on.

We are using only Patio A and part of Room 101 for vendor sales. Our exhibit area will be the same as a regular park show. Unfortunately, this means we will not have room for individual tabletop or floor displays. There will still be a Kid's Corner and free orchid classes. We also decided on earlier opening times on Friday. Everyone got quite tired of waiting last year and everything should be ready, so we will open.

We have a good roster of 19 vendors including Conservation and Member Sales. We will have three 10x30 tents on the patio for vendors, and good spaces in Room 101 as well. There will be a larger area reserved for member sales in Room 101, but please let me know in advance if you plan to participate. There will be cashiers and plant hotels on both the patio and room 101. We will be providing lunch for all volunteers and vendors.

There should be plenty of orchids in bloom to make our exhibit area spectacular. We hope some of them will be yours! Pam Peters and I will be presenting the Culture Class in March with details and ideas for helping you participate in the show. Pre-registration forms will be sent out in April.

We have a new Volunteer coordinator. Many thanks to Tom Corzine for taking over from Dave Hoffmaster, who is retiring. There will be signup sheets at the March meeting and on the Volunteers section of the website. Please plan to be part of our biggest and best show of the year! We need you and it's fun to be part of the circus. Of course, you will earn a Volunteer Reward Coupon for every day you work. Thank you!


