NEWCOMERS POTTING WORKSHOP - MAY 17

Attention New Members! We are having another workshop on May 17. The focus will be on repotting cymbidiums, with a side focus on phalaenopsis. The meeting will be held at Debby Halliday's house in Rancho Santa Fe.

We are pleased to welcome Darcy Salzl as our main instructor. She has been repotting cymbidiums for our members for years and by her own count has done well over 1000. She is known in SDCOS circles as the go-to person if you want your cymbidium repotted well. She should have lots of tips and tricks to make us all feel like experts.

Ben Machado will provide us with medium and pots. He is an excellent resource for supplies and has promised to bring an assortment of samples and even some extra bark and pots if you need any. We've asked him to give a brief presentation on what he can offer to those of you looking for a good local supplier of all things orchid.

This is a BYOP (bring your own plant) session. We are asking for a nominal fee of \$5 per plant to cover materials and pots. If you don't have a cymbidium, bring a phalaenopsis, or anything else that likes bark and needs repotting and we'll help you repot it. As usual, we'll have some experienced members around to answer questions and give advice.

After we finish with our plants, we hope you'll stay for coffee and cookies and conversation. You're invited to take a walk around Debby's garden and greenhouse. I'm sure you'll enjoy it.

Letter from the Editor

Dear SDCOS,
